

YELLOW BRICK ROAD QUILT

- Yellow Brick Road Pattern by Terry Atkinson Fabric requirements:
- 6 Fat Quarters These must be Fat Quarters (not long quarter yards) to be able to cut in the appropriate manner!
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yd for borders *Using this yardage, you'll not have to piece borders J
- Check pattern fabric requirements if you wish to purchase backing and binding fabric for later.
- Rotary cutting supplies: 2 rulers, one which is at least 6.5"x 12", (* one 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 12" and one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 12" is ideal!)
- Basic sewing supplies: Thread, scissors, pins and a seam ripper (hopefully you won't need it!)
- Sewing machine with manual . Please have a working knowledge of your machine before class.
- A quarter inch presser foot is very helpful in the construction of this quilt.

5D POCKET CALENDAR COVER

- Laptop computer with 5D extra or Professional installed, dongle, power cord, mouse and mouse pad (easier to do with a mouse)
- Embroidery machine and embroidery unit, power cord, R foot, accessory tray with all feet.
- 240 x 150 or 260 x 200 hoop (whichever one you have)
- Two layers of regular weight Tear-a-way stabilizer
- One pocket calendar
- 1/2 yard cotton fabric (calico OK, but not too busy of a print)
- Assorted colors of 40wt rayon thread
- Pre-wound bobbin for embroidery
- All-purpose sewing thread and bobbin to match color of fabric
- 80/12 universal needle
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler (ruler is important)
- Disappearing fabric marker
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, etc.)

If you are interested in taking a class and do not have, or do not want to bring your own sewing machine, Yapple's can provide one. We use Husqvarna Viking's Emerald 116, which is a very nice, basic machine. Please ask if one is available for your class. We can give you a quick lesson.

SUPPLY LISTS 2011

BASKET & BUTTONS TEA TOWEL

- Sewing machine and embroidery unit in good working order.
- #75-90 embroidery needle
- #100 wing needle or #110 universal or topstitch needle
- White 60 or 80 wt heirloom sewing thread
- Sulky rayon 40 wt thread: 241-dark ash, 1817 lemon grass and 561-lipstick
- Washout marker, Edge joining foot, button sew-on foot and ruler
- Bring sack lunch if you like.

JUST FOR KIDS CLASSES

Material, thread, and sewing machines will be provided. If student has a sewing box with basic sewing supplies with scissors and pins, they can bring that.

QUICK TRIP QUILT: BEGINNER 42" x 52"

- Body of quilt: 6 different fabrics, 1/4 yard each
- 1st Border: 1/4 yard
- 2nd Border: 1 yard
- Please bring fabrics pressed and ready to cut
- The following are not required at class time, but you will need it to complete your quilt: 3 yards for backing and 1/2 yard if making cross-grain binding.
- Sewing machine in good working order and manual, if needed; or reserve one of Yapple's Emerald 116s
- 1/4" sewing foot or guide
- Thread to match or a neutral, scissors, pins, seam ripper
- Rotary cutter, mat and 12" x 6" and/or 24" x 6"

MENDING

- Yapple's will provide the sewing machines and basic sewing supplies. If you have an item in need of hemming, mending or repair, please bring it and matching thread, patches, etc.
- Bring pen and paper for taking notes
- We will touch on darning, sewing on buttons and more.

"SNAP HAPPY" PURSE

- Two fat quarters of coordinating fabrics
- Several three to four inch squares of coordinating fabric for Prairie point tabs for each bag
- A 3/4" metal carpenter's measuring tape (will be cut)
- 1/2 yard of fusible pella light weight batting
- 1/4 yard of light weight interfacing
- Masking tape or duct tape
- Assorted trims, cording, ribbon, beads, swivel snap
- Basic sewing supplies, thread to match, old scissors to cut metal tape
- Sewing machine in good working order

OUTDOOR ENSEMBLE

- Sewing machine in good working order
- One twin sheet set will give you placemats, tablecloth, napkins, hot pads and food covers
- For 4 placemats you will need a bottom fitted sheet with all the elastic cut off
- 1 1/4 yard of batting
- 2 yards of grosgrain ribbon
- Basic sewing supplies, good quality all-purpose thread, pins, tape measure, etc.

QUILTED BAG

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- Magnetic closure (optional)
- 1/2 yard reversible quilted fabric
- 1/2 yard coordinating fabric for lining
- 1 package of arched bamboo or plastic purse handles size 6 1/2" by 5"

SHOWER CURTAIN BEACH BAG

- Fabric shower curtain
- Coordinating fabric for pockets
- Basic sewing supplies, including matching thread
- Sewing machine in good working order

GIRL'S T-SHIRT DRESS

- **Serger in GOOD working condition**
- **Serger handbook, power cord, foot pedal, and accessories (tweezers required).**
- **Gathering or shirring foot for your serger (Yaple's will give you a discount) Give them time to order if they don't have it in stock, so ask early.**
- **Scissors, pins, double eyed needle or tapestry needle with large eye**
- **4 cones Serger thread to coordinate with t-shirt and fabric**
- **Purchased t-shirt**

Wash both your fabric and t-shirt before cutting.

Determine the desired length of the skirt. Divide by 2, this will give you 2 tiers.

The width of the tier is determined by the size of the t-shirt. The top tier should be 1 3/4 times the width of each section (front and back).

The bottom 2 tiers should be 2x the width of each section.

Example: if the t-shirt section widths (front and back) are 12".....12+12=24 so the tier widths are 42" and the bottom tiers are 48" wide. If the desired length is 14" each tier is 7" long. You will need 5, 7" lengths of skirt fabric or 1 yd of fabric

You will have 5 pieces that are 7"x 41" or 45" depending on the width of your purchased fabric.

Interfacing: 1/2" wide x the width of the hem of the t-shirt.

I will provide knit and cotton for you to try your shirring foot

HEIRLOOM SEWING: BEGINNER

- Sewing machine in good working order that does straight stitch and zig zag.
- Size 70 universal needle
- Lightweight sewing thread (50 or 60 wt.)
- Blue washout marker
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, measuring tape, pins)

HEIRLOOM BOWTIE QUILT: SERGER

- Serger in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- More supplies to follow...

4D/5D BUTTERFLY BROACH

- Laptop computer with either 4D or 5D Extra or Professional installed, Embroidery Software Dongle, power cord, mouse and mouse pad
- Husqvarna Viking Embroidery Machine and embroidery unit, plus USB stick or whatever your machine takes to transfer designs from computer to machine
- 240 x 150 or 260 x 200 hoop
- Two layers of Aqua Magic water-soluble stabilizer, bigger than your hoop to have at least 1" all around
- Scraps of organza fabric (about 4-6 colors)
- White organza to fit your hoop
- Size 90 topstitch machine needle
- Seed beads to compliment your butterfly colors
- Hand sewing needle
- Temporary Spray Adhesive (Sulky KK200 is good)
- Regular sewing thread and matching bobbin (darker than organza colors)
- Fine point scissors
- Small hand towel (speed up during process after stabilizer is rinsed away)

BAG IT- SERGER

- **Serger in GOOD working condition**
- **Serger handbook, power cord, foot pedal, and accessories (tweezers required)**
- **Scissors, a few straight pins**
- **1 cone serger thread, 2 spools of 12 wt. cotton Sulky thread to blend or contrast with your fabric**
- **large safety pin or bodkin to thread elastic into casing**

- **Old jeans or 5/8 yd denim or heavy sport weight fabric. Cut this into three 6"x19" pieces**
 - **1/8 yd of contrasting or coordinating fabric (lighter wt. cotton) Cut this into two 17 1/2"x2 1/2" strips for casings**
 - **8" piece of 1/2" elastic**
 - **12" piece of grosgrain ribbon**
- If you are purchasing a kit the last 4 items will be in the kit, but no thread. You may purchase thread, the day of class. Cut Main fabric 27 1/2"x41"cut border fabric 11"x 41"**
- If you are purchasing a kit, only the fabric is included.**

KEEPSAKE FRAME CARDS

- Sewing machine in good working order, screw driver, extra 80/12 universal needles
- Stitch in the Ditch foot, preferably clear, it's easier to follow lines
- Regular machine sewing thread in silver or light gray with a full bobbin to match
- 4" x 3" quilt ruler (minimum size, can be bigger)
- A fine disappearing ink fabric marker and a regular fabric marker, fine pt.
- Kit will include fabric scraps, batting, stabilizer, quilt pattern,

ONE HOUR PURSE

- Fabrics below will also be used for pockets and trim
- 1 yard of fabric for the outside of the purse
- 1 yard of coordinating fabric for lining
- 3/4 yard of batting for in-between
- Magnetic snap
- 2 buttons that look good with material
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine in good working order

OVER-THE-DOOR ORGANIZER

- Sewing machine in good working order
- One flat sheet
- 3/4" elastic
- One package of bias tape
- Basic sewing supplies

HEMMING AND MORE

- Sewing machine in good working order and all accessories, or reserve one of Yapple's machines
- Basic sewing supplies
- Pen and paper for taking notes
- Something that needs to be hemmed, darned (small hole), mended (ex: patch), and/or needs a button with matching thread.

HEIRLOOM PILLOW

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Good quality white thread, preferably 60wt
- Basic sewing supplies
- 70 universal needles
- 1.6/70 double needle
- Bodkin
- Blue washout marker
- Edge-joining foot
- 7 groove pintuk foot

HUSKYLOCK OWNERS

- Serger in good working order with all accessories, manual
- Basic sewing supplies
- Two different light spools of thread or cones
- Two different dark spools of thread or cones
- Extra needles size 80 and 90
- One spool of specialty thread (candlelight, serger yarn or pearl crown rayon)

PILLOWCASE DRESS

- A purchased pillowcase or optional fabric
- 2 yards of coordinating ribbon
- Single wide bias tape (coordinating color)
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- Optional embellishment of your choice (lace, buttons, pockets)

INTRO TO SEWING: ADULTS

Material, thread, supplies and sewing machines will be provided. Bring a notebook and pen for taking notes.

FREE MOTION: BEGINNER

- Sewing machine in good working order, manual. Please have a good working knowledge of it
- Know how to drop your feed dogs
- Free motion sewing foot that properly fits your machine before class. This is a must have.
- Basic sewing supplies
- Pad of paper for drawing (Computer paper is just the right size!)
- At least 2 pencils
- 4-6 approx. 20" x20" quilt sandwiches of plain muslin and cotton batting. Baste using your favorite method, ready for practice
- Optional: quilting gloves for better traction to hold onto your quilt sandwiches.

SERGER SIMPLE-BEGINNER

- **Serger in GOOD working condition**
- **Serger handbook, power cord, foot pedal, and accessories (tweezers required).**
- **4 cones of serger thread, 2 light and 2 dark in color scissors, a few straight pins, double eyed needle or**
- **Pillow case supplies: 7/8 yard main color cotton or cotton/poly blend**
- **1/3 yd. border fabric in complimentary or contrast color**
Cut Main fabric 27 1/2"x41".....cut border fabric 11"x 41"

If you are purchasing a kit, only the fabric is included.

FREE STANDING ANGEL DOLL

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- 1/3 yard flesh colored, non-stretch fabric
- Thread to match
- Fiber fill
- 1/2 yd fabric of choice for gown (ex: white, ecru)
- \$16 Kit will include: Cone, wings, pearls for necklace, little star, halo, gold or silver trim, hat pins for earrings, wigs, paint and brushes for face
